COUNSELOR REQUIREMENTS

If your group can provide a minimum of 2 adults each of the same gender for the youth you are bringing, that is always helpful and enables us to more easily abide by Safe Sanctuary guidelines.

However, at a minimum, each group needs to bring one counselor* for up to 6 youth of the same gender. Example: 3 males and 10 females requires 1 male counselor and 2 female counselors. *Counselors must be at least 4 years older than the oldest youth they will supervise.

**If your group is unable to find counselor(s), pay the registration fee for the number you need and Lakeshore will recruit them for you. Mark this on the form above -this request MUST be made at least 2 weeks in advance of the retreat.
